

# HP Retail Publishing Solutions Supplies shelf life



HP supplies are designed to extend well beyond the typical storage period for retail photo departments, assuring retailers and consumers the best images possible. All supplies should be stored covered (away from direct sunlight) in a cool, dry place, and in the original packaging.

## Shelf life, from when retailer receives supply:

Poster Media	Two years for HP Premium Instant-dry Satin Photo Paper (Q9999A and CG931A) <sup>1</sup> One year for HP Artist Matte Canvas (Q8704A) <sup>2</sup>
LaserJet Media	One year <sup>2</sup>
LaserJet Toner	Two years
Photo Book covers	Three years
Dymo Labels	Twelve months
Receipt Paper	Twelve months

<sup>1</sup> If stored unopened in original packaging.

<sup>2</sup> If kept in sealed packaging and away from direct sunlight.

Example use of the following tables: If a #70 ink cartridge for a Z3100 arrives at the retailer five months after being manufactured, there will be 19 months (24-5) of shelf life prior to the install-by date. Further, the ink cartridge will have 25 months of warranty (19+6) after arriving at the retailer.

Typical time from date of manufacture to arrival at the retailer is under six months.

Printers will print with expired ink, but changing cartridges is recommended since using expired ink may result in reduced print quality.
